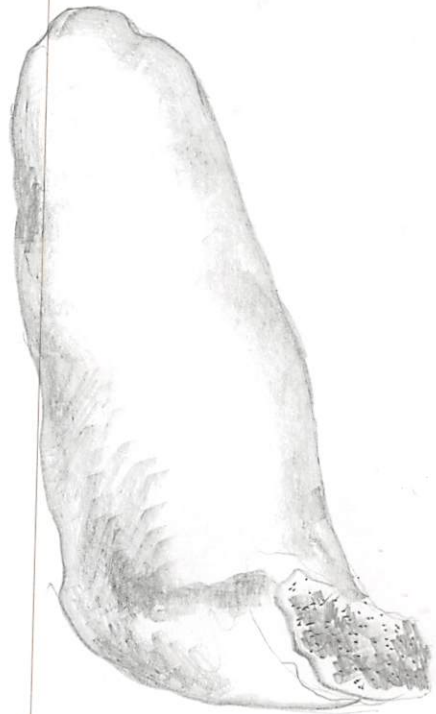

Full Verbal Description

Censer. Prong & plate fragment from a complex  
 Very thick firing core (0.8 cm thick of the  
 1.3 cm thick plate). No decorations evident, though  
 some longitudinal striations along prong can be seen.  
 The vent hole is directly above the plate & is roughly  
 designed & badly finished. It is roughly circular, about  
 0.8 - 1.0 cm diam. There is some evidence of blackening  
 from fire on tip, but bc of erosion, it is difficult to  
 determine extent. Significant burning on top & rim of  
 plate, w/ charring into paste 0.1 cm on left side of  
 prong, where it is most burnt. Also extensive burning  
 along both edges of prong from tip to plate & down  
 the side opposite vent hole almost 5 cm.
