GRAVITY'S RAINBOW

The works consist of three parts: The main body hanging in space. the floor and the ceiling.

I. The main body is an arrangement of 24 fluoros hanging 180cm from metal chains. This serves to demonstrate cyclical movements and changes in electricity. light, speed and time. The works are only a cross—section of the endless succession of movements.

II. The floor is composed of pieces of glass and painted tree trunks and roots. These materials are put together randomly to hold down certain simple concepts. These concepts refer to parts of the human body and all contain the concept of "number". The whole device is a circle, or rather, the shadows cast by the lights on the ground.

III. The ceiling consists of 24 mirrors in the same form as the floor and reflecting it.
