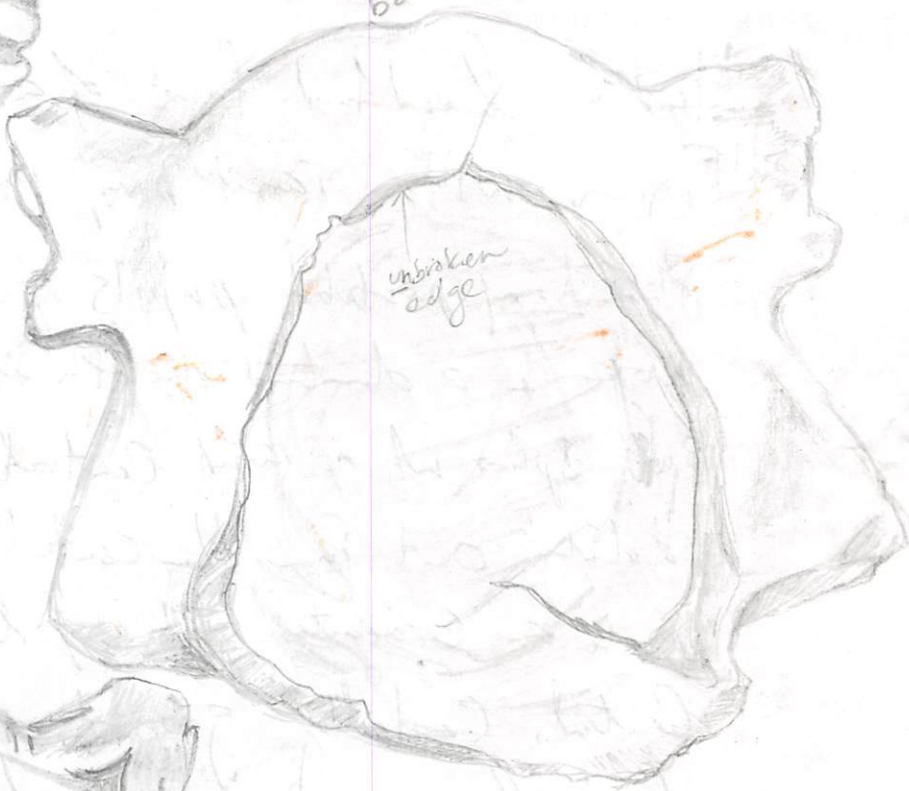

VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Head + headband fragment of a large, hollow, anthropomorphic  
Figurine with raised brows, raised eyebrows + lid eyes closed.  
Shaped w/ protruded pupils, a large bushy triangular  
nose + a downturned mouth w/ lip tips. Two earflaps  
over sphs w/ a raised central sphs + 4 more  
radiating out from the central sphs. The hair is cut  
into a graduated fringe/layer w/ wavy grooves + a  
central, centrally grouped rectangular patch. The  
head has a raised <sup>head</sup> band w/ a broad dangling flange  
w/ raised sphs on each side + an undulating central flange.  
The neck is recessed. The back is convex. The site  
is smooth. No big damage. Frag holes on back of head  
Light traces of any slips. A very realistically  
rendered face.
