I'm the Electronic Resources and Scholarly Communications Librarian for the Briggs Library here at South Dakota State University. I'm in charge of the daily operations of the SDSU institutional repository: Open PRAIRIE. https://openprairie.sdstate.edu/

Open PRAIRIE came online in late 2015. Since that time all graduate work (Electronic Theses and Dissertations- ETDs) is being placed in the repository for preservation, and dissemination. This includes your thesis: Gender portrayal in J.K. Rowling's Harry Potter and the Order of the Phoenix: A Feminist Rhetorical Criticism https://openprairie.sdstate.edu/etd/5143/
