VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Fragment of a candelero with 2 whole and 9 partial chambers preserved. Hobs are irregular, much narrower at the bottom, with a step-out about half-way up. Temper is prominent, up to 0.71 cm across. No clear burning. Exterior is smoothed, but paste is most like Junguillo. The 2 preserved vent holes are 0.32 cm dia. Chambers are up to 3.35 cm deep. Vents are about 0.6 cm above the base.
