



## How do I find a journal article?

You have two ways of finding a journal article.

1. If you need to find a *specific* journal article, such as one that is on a reading list

- Scroll down the <u>Library homepage</u> to the search box and select LibrarySearch
- Search for the journal article title, in this case 'Compliance Versus Innovation in Evidence-Based Nursing'

We've put the useful ones for health care onto one web page for you to access easily.


