Town Warrant

THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Exeter, in the County of Rockingham, in said State, qualified to vote in Town Affairs: [L. S.]

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Exeter on Tuesday, the tenth day of March next, at ten of the clock in the forenoon, to act upon the following subjects:

- 1st. To choose by ballot and plurality vote a town clerk.
- 2d. To choose by ballot and plurality vote one selectman for three years.
- 3d. To choose by ballot and plurality vote one trustee of the Robinson Female Seminary for the term of seven years.
- 4th. To choose by ballot and plurality vote one trustee of the trust funds held by the town of Exeter, to hold office for three years.
- 5th. To choose by ballot and plurality vote one trustee of the Swasey Parkway for three years.
- 6th. To choose all other necessary town officers, auditors, or committees for the ensuing year.
- 7th. To see what sums of money the town will raise and appropriate for the maintenance of the poor, for repairing highways, for repairing and building bridges, for repairing and building sidewalks, for building drains and sewers, for oiling streets, for payment of the town debt, for lighting streets, for defraying expenses of decorating the graves of soldiers, for preventing the spread of insect pests within the town, for the control of the white pine blister disease, for the payment of firemen for the ensuing year, and for other charges arising within the town.

8th. To hear the reports of agents, auditors, and other officers and committees heretofore chosen and pass any vote arising therefrom.

9th. To see if the town will vote to authorize the town treasurer, with the approval of the selectmen, to borrow money in anticipation of taxes.

10th. To see if the town will vote to authorize the water commissioners, with the approval of the selectmen, to borrow money in anticipation of revenue.

11th. To see what action the town will take by ballot on the following question: "Shall the provisions of Chapter 171-A of the Revised Laws relative to playing games of beano be declared no longer in effect in this town."

12th. On petition of Dennis J. Callahan and eleven others to see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate not more than the sum of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars to be used toward installation, decoration and expense of Christmas lighting in the town.

13th. On petition of Clarence Palmer and fifty-eight others, to see if the town will vote to install 1,250 feet of eight-inch water main, from the end of present main in front of residence of Ralph Richard to the residence of Everett C. Dillon, to include two hydrants and appropriate the sum of \$7,200 for the same.

14th. To see if the town will vote to continue the authority of the present planning board, and to authorize and empower it to regulate new Housing Developments and trailer camps by the approval or disapproval of plans submitted to it by the owners of proposed developments and camps, approval or disapproval to be based upon regulations to be adopted by the Planning Board and filed for record in the Office of the Register of Deeds, and appropriate \$150.00 for expenses.

15th. To see if the town will vote to adopt a Zoning Ordinance in accordance with the report of the Planning Board as formulated at two Public Hearings and presented at this Town Meeting and appropriate \$150.00 for expenses.

16th. To see if the town will vote to appropriate a sum not to exceed twelve hundred dolars (\$1,200.00) to purchase an Addressograph machine and equipment, for the purpose of systematizing the real estate assessment list, inventory blanks and tax bills.

17th. On petition of Daniel P. Herlihy and ten others to see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of eight hundred dollars (\$800.00) for the purpose of eight concerts to be played in the Swasey Pavillion by the Exeter Brass Band during the summer of 1953.

18th. To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.

Report of State Tax Commission DIVISION OF MUNICIPAL ACCOUNTING

CONCORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE, January 16, 1953.

Board of Selectmen, Exeter, New Hampshire

Gentlemen: Submitted herewith is the report of the annual audit and examination of the accounts of the Town of Exeter for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1952, which was made by this Division in accordance with the vote of the Town. Exhibits as hereafter listed are included as part of the report.

Scope of Audit

Included in the audit and examination were the accounts and records of the Board of Selectmen, Treasurer, Tax Collector, Town Clerk, Road Agent, Library Treasurer, Clerk of the Municipal Court, Trustees of Swasey Parkway, Trustees of Trust Funds and Water Department.

Financial Statements

Comparative Balance Sheets — December 31, 1951 -

December 31, 1952: (Exhibit A-1)

Comparative Balance Sheets as of December 31, 1951, and December 31, 1952, are presented in Exhibit A-1. As indicated therein, the Net Debt decreased by \$47,517.81 during the year, 1952.

Analysis of Change in Financial Condition:

(Exhibit A-2)

An analysis of the change in financial condition of the Town during the year is made in Exhibit A-2, with the factors which caused the change indicated therein.

Comparative Statements of Appropriations and Expenditures — Estimated and Actual Revenues:

(Exhibits A-3 and A-4)

Comparative statements of appropriations and expenditures, estimated and actual revenues for the fiscal

year ended December 31, 1952, are presented in Exhibits A-3 and A-4. As indicated by the budgetary summary (Exhibit A-4), a net unexpended balance of appropriations of \$3,517.91, plus a revenue surplus of \$5,285.84, resulted in a net budget surplus of \$8,803.75.

Summary of Receipts and Expenditures: (Exhibit B-1)

A summary of receipts and expenditures for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1952, made up in accordance with the uniform classification of accounts, is included in Exhibit B-1. Proof of the Treasurer's balance, as of December 31, 1952, is indicated in Exhibit B-2.

Statement of Bonded Debt: (Exhibit K-1)

A statement of bonded debt, as of December 31, 1952, showing annual debt service requirements, is contained in Exhibit K-1.

Water Department: (Exhibits L-1 and L-2)

The Water Department section of the report is included in Exhibits L-1 and L-2.

Audit Procedure

The accounts and records of all town officials charged with the custody, receipt and disbursement of public funds were examined and audited. Vouchers and cancelled checks were compared with supporting invoices and payrolls as well as entries in the books of record. Receipts were checked by source insofar as possible and totals of receipts and expenditures verified. Book balances were verified by comparison with reconciled bank balances made from statements obtained from depository banks. Verification of uncollected taxes was made by mailing notices to delinquent taxpayers as indicated by the Collector's records.

General Comments

Current Surplus:

A continued improvement in the current financial condition of the Town was noted in 1952, the current surplus being increased from \$540.64 to \$14,039.32 dur-

Once again I am pleased to announce that an increase of four thousand and one hundred twenty-three (4,123) books were taken out of the juvenile department this year. The adults did not measure up as well but there was an increase of seven hundred and thirty four.

The New Hampshire Library Association Annual Meeting held here May 8th and 9th at the Congregational Church with your library and the Davis Library as hosts proved to be a most successful affair and the attendance was excellent.

In July your librarian went to New York to the American Library Association Annual Meeting. It was a most stimulating and worth while conference.

We are rendering a new service with the assistance of the churches of the town. Women from the various organizations drive one of the staff twice a month to the Eventide Home. We take a sizable quantity of books for the ladies there to choose from and also take any requests for books they would especially care for. It is a service we all are glad to do and we are enjoying it too.

Mr. William Dudley arranged several attractive exhibits in the Exeter Historical Society Show Case. During January antique and Victorian fans, loaned by the Society for the preservation of New England Antiquities were shown. This was followed by tea cups and saucers, showing the different sizes and shapes that have been used over a long period of years. Ribbons and accessories of other days was another pleasing exhibit.

During Art Week Mrs. Hight, town art supervisor, provided us with an admirable exhibit of work done by the students of the town schools. It was a credit to both instructor and students.

Seven story hours were held during 1952 in the Juvenile department. I regret to report that the attendance has dropped off so much that we feel it is advis-

able to discontinue them for a while. We wish to express our thanks and sincere appreciation to all those people who have assisted us in various ways with the work. However, we do plan from time to time to play records on the victrola Saturday afternoons.

The library committee has purchased two bays of steel shelfing for our magazines which we keep over a period of years. We are extremely grateful for these as in times past it has been quite a chore to keep them in

good condition on several tables.

A new oak shelf unit for the juvenile room has been ordered. This will make the fourth and should be suffi-

cient for several years.

The continued loyal support of the staff and the splendid cooperation of the Library Committee are much appreciated by the librarian.

Report of Water Commissioners

To the Board of Water Commissionerss

I herewith submit my report as Superintendent for

the year ending Dec. 31, 1952.

All water pumped during the year came from the new well in Gilman Park. The water was tested and found to be of excellent quality, notwithstanding the complaints of taste and odor. These were caused by the incrustation on the inside of the old pipes of the distribution system, which was dislodged by the new water and the increase in pressure moving in a new direction.

Many hours were spent flushing the lines which did much to improve conditions. During the past three months we have chlorinated the water which we were advised would help to improve conditions. We hope

that this trouble is now over.

The year was one of progress in the department. Much maintenance was done including the cleaning of 4,375 feet of six-inch cast iron main on High Street. Most of this pipe had been in service since 1886 and several tons of incrustation was removed. This made a definite improvement in the flow of water through this line.

The new three-quarter ton service truck purchased

by the department fills a long felt need.

We are adding new services in increasing numbers. This increases our expenses at this time but will in time pay off in increased earnings.

The consumption of water increased by 4,060,500 gallons over the previous year. We are fortunate to

have an ample supply at this time.

I recommend that a sinking fund be created to take care of the cost of a new standpipe to replace the old one near the Exeter Hospital when it comes to the time that it has to be done. This is the original standpipe erected when the plant was built in 1886. Fifty years is considered normal life for such a structure. We should expect not over 10 more years of service and it might be much less.


