MR. DUROCHER RETURNS TO LOWE



Returning to W. D. Lowe as principal has been a rewarding move in my career. My past association with the school and my affection for its teaching staff and student body have meant much to me personally. Now, as I leaf through this fine edition of "TOWERS", I feel proud that I have had some share in their accomplishments during this school year.

I have to admit that, because of a combination of circumstances, the first few weeks of this school year were "rough". But now, with extensive renovation and redecoration, with the provision of many new lockers and with the installation of new clocks, the building is better than it has been for years. For me, there has been a certain satisfaction in knowing that, on the practical side, we have achieved some improvements which work for the comfort of both staff and students.

But my greatest satisfaction comes as I look over the pages of graduates' photos in this book. The co-operation and good-will of this year's graduating class make them worthy representatives of the finest tradition of W. D. Lowe. My good wishes, those of Mr. Harrison, of Mr. Neilson, and of all the teachers go with them as they proceed to further education or take up work for which the school has trained them.

Now I want to mention some of the changes which lie ahead for our school. Next year, we shall operate as a non-graded school on a credit system with individual timetabling. I am confident that, with a wider choice of subjects and with continued subject promotion, we shall be able to fulfil the educational needs of our students better than ever. An even greater change may come within the next three years when W. D. Lowe will probably become fully composite. This means that the school will be equipped to offer a wide range of subjects -- academic, technical and commercial. It will then have the proud role of providing education to the young men and women of the inner city.

Naturally the projected development as a composite school has raised some questions about our name and our tradition. My own pride in W. D. Lowe is such that I believe its tradition can never be destroyed. On the contrary, as the school helps more and more young people in the development of their possibilities, its name and its history can only be enhanced.

The production of this yearbook took work and courage. I am deeply grateful to its editor, Ed Mock, and to all who worked to make it the fine record which it is. I shall treasure my own copy of "TOWERS" for it will recall to me the accomplishment and excitement of my first year as principal at Lowe.

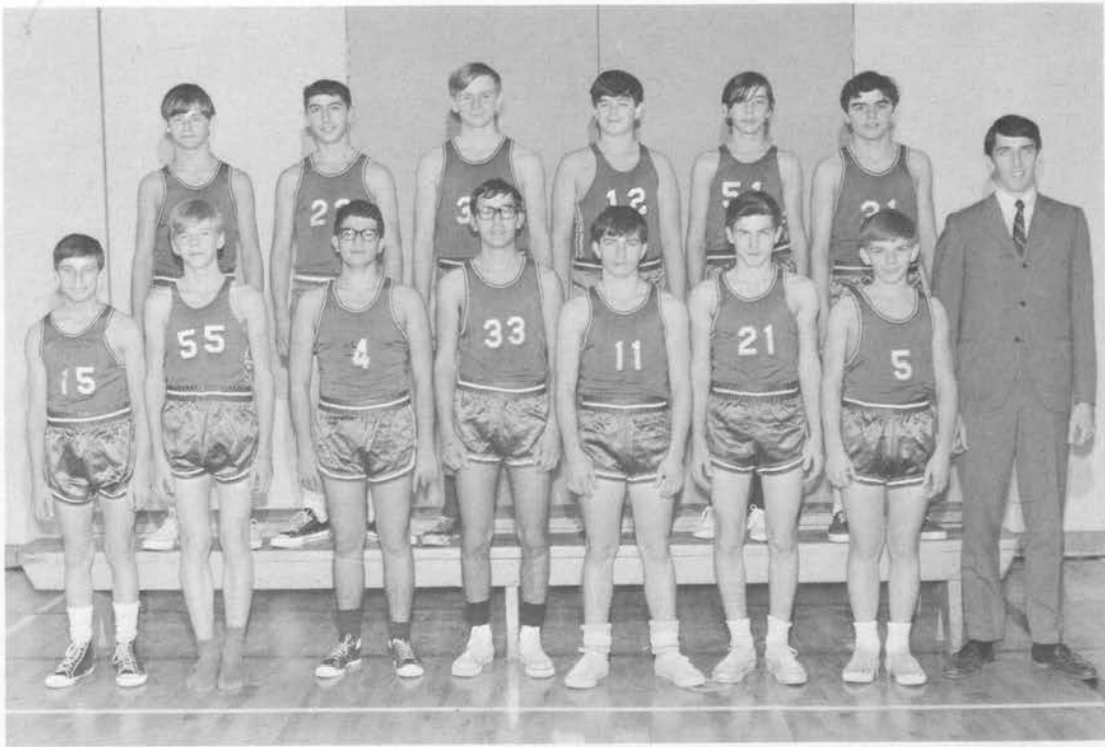
During the three months of action Ross Miles, Eugene Crosby, and Bob Ouellette displayed a potential which should be realized in the senior ranks.

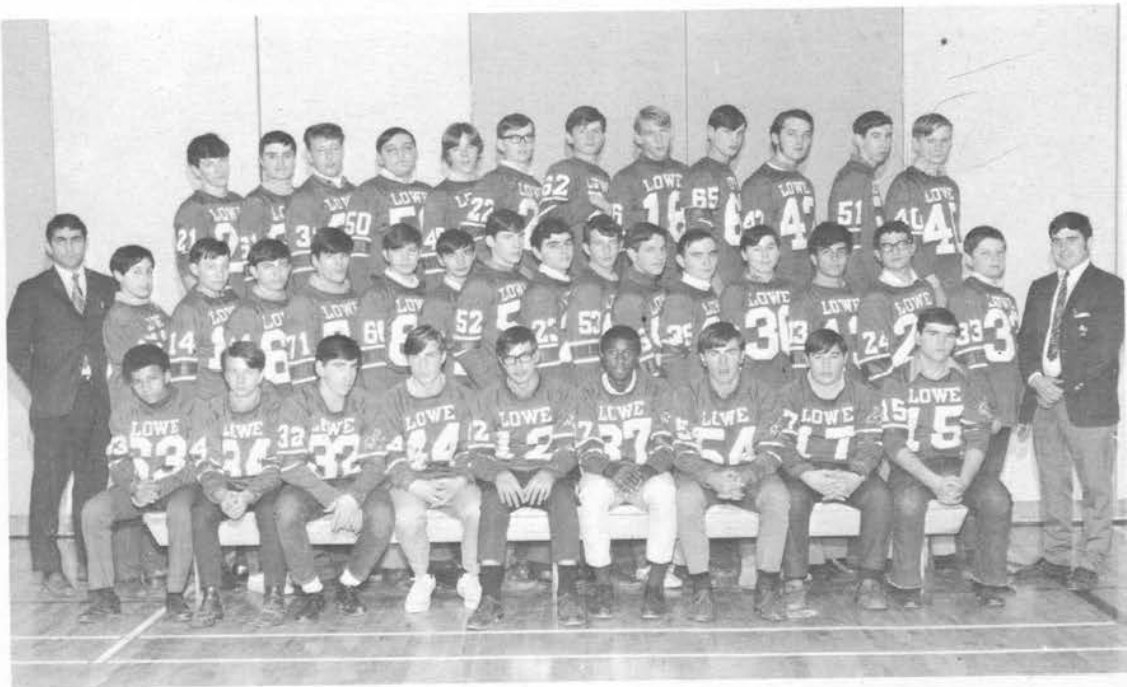

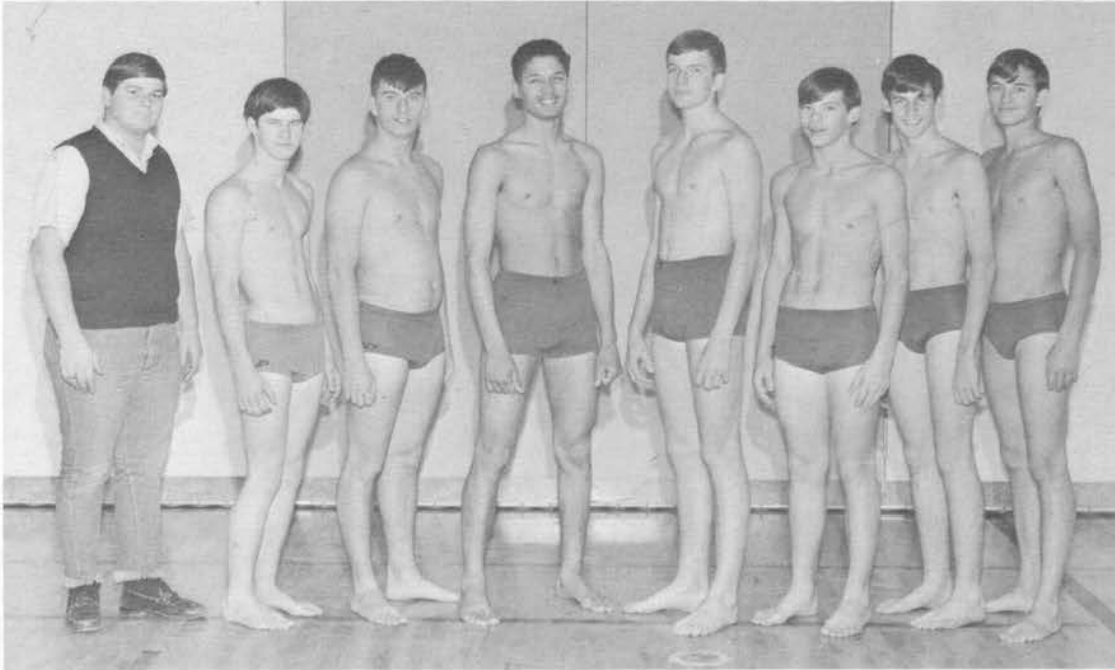

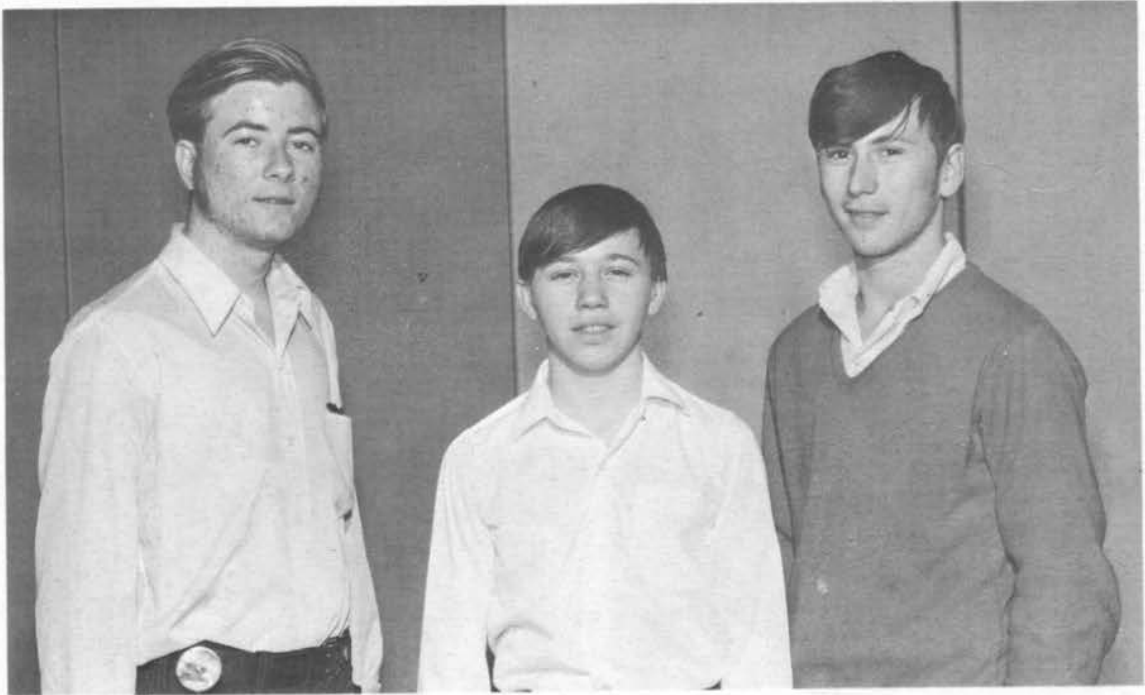

The dedication this year is to Mr. L. F. McGee, a member of the staff at Lowe for 30 years. I feel that this is a significant way to recognize his dedication and service.

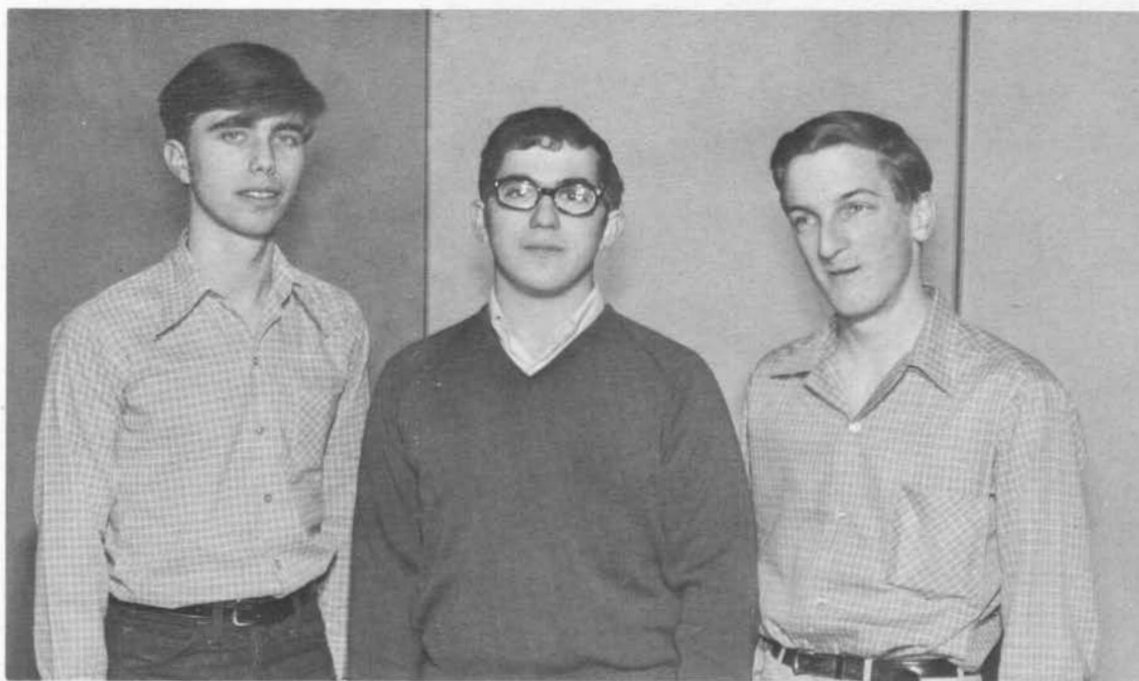
