Differences between people with long-term pain who swim & those who do not swim



1.40% (n=273) people with long-term pain had swum in the last 12 months

Age range **17 to 87** years (M=53, SD=13.23)

Conclusions

 The Active Lives dataset suggests **very few** people with long-term pain swim
