# Skin-to-Skin Contact

The practice where a baby is dried and laid directly on their parent's bare chest after birth, both covered in a warm blanket and left until after the first feed.

### Benefits



Reduces Risk of Hypothermia

> Decreases Infant Mortality Rates



Increases Success of Breastfeeding

Increases Overall
Maternal Satisfaction



# Statistics

Comparing success of breastfeeding with use of SSC versus standard contact

| Category       | SSC | Standard |
|----------------|-----|----------|
| Everett Nipple | 84% | 65%      |
| Comfort        | 89% | 88%      |
| No Assistance  | 36% | 23%      |
| Total Success  | 48% | 46%      |
