## ARIEL ANNOUNCES A NEW JOURNAL

John E. Keller of the Department of Spanish and Italian at our University, founded the Society of the Cantigueiros de Santa María in 1986, which is, an informal group of scholars devoted to research on the <u>Cantigas de Santa María</u> of King Alfonso X, el Sabio. The Society will sponsor sections at conferences and meetings of scholars, will occasionally hold research meetings, and will publish twice a year the <u>Bulletin of the Cantigueiros de Santa María</u>, whose first number appeared recently. Volume I concentrated on research opportunities in the <u>Cantigas</u>. Subsequent volumes will continue to print such articles, and will, of course, publish articles on specific studies relating to King Alfonso's favorite book.
