April 27, 1940

Dear Mrs. Gardner:

Some time ago you made a contribution on the remodeling of Brittain Church. You will be glad to know that crushed rock ^{and} sand have already been delivered, and that work is to begin on the Church very soon.

We expect to have fourteen or fifteen art-glass windows in the church auditorium ^{and} vestibule. Most of these are to be memorial windows. There are to be one or more to Longs, Watsons, McFarlands, etc., but as yet no one has arranged to have one for any of the Andrews. I have been talking with Mrs. Bigham ^{and} we think it will be too bad if there is not at least one window for an Andrews.

It might be for Mr. Samuel Andrews - 1750 to 1810. He is the first listed as an elder of Brittain Church; or it might any one of their descendants. You know more about the family than I. Do you not think that some of the Chapmans, or Andrews or Twittys or others would be glad to give toward a window. The window will cost about \$30. and lettering ^(#2⁰⁰) would make the total about \$32⁰⁰. Would you be willing to talk it over with a number of your cousins or other kins-folks & arrange for this? We will appreciate it very much; and we hope to have a church building you will be proud of.

I will be glad to hear from you when you have time to write.
