



RESULTS OF SEED TESTS

Made July 1, 1922 to June 30, 1923

The laboratory has completed tests on 553 samples of seed during the past year. In a majority of the cases both germination and purity determinations have been made indicating that well over 1000 separate indices to quality have been thus computed. As these tests are usually duplicated from two to five times in each instance for the purpose of arriving at a suitable average and to eliminate any possible inconsistencies, the few official figures herewith presented hardly express the scope of the work.

This bulletin shows the records of tests based on what we choose to call official samples. They represent the seeds collected by the State Department of Agriculture and tested by us for conformity with their printed guarantees.

Persons interested in the State Seed Law will find it printed in last year's seed bulletin or may obtain copies by writing the State Department of Agriculture at Concord.

The seed testing regulatory work should be largely a preventative of trouble. It should keep poor or undesirable seed off the market either by assisting the conscientious vender to make sure that his product is not sold under false pretenses or by preventing the "gyp" from flooding the market with a cheaper product which he knows may be practically worthless. Our investigation of seeds is not expected to find poor seed unless such is on the market nor to make unnecessary trouble for any person or company that does a legitimate business.

Seed testing work has now been in vogue in this country as a service of insurance for the farmer against the necessary use of seed of unknown quality for some

fifty years, but it is much more recently that a large proportion of the states have established seed testing laboratories. Connecticut did some of this work as early as 1877. A laboratory was started in Washington, D. C., by the Federal Government in 1894. Since that time the work has spread rapidly among the states, while investigation and research have developed many improvements in methods of testing. In 1908 the American Association of Official Seed Analysts was formed for the purpose of standardizing methods and stimulating investigation which would lead to more uniform results. This association is a very active organization and is doing much to improve the technique of its members. The New Hampshire seed testing work was started in 1909.

Probably few people realize today some of the wilful practices which were resorted to in the days previous to the inauguration of any seed control work for the purpose of defrauding the public along this line. Old seed was sold for new, perhaps after coloring or polishing to make it look superior. Kale was sold for cabbage, trefoil for alfalfa and so on to some length. The farmer had no recourse to secure justice even if he had reason to suspect or could prove that he had been defrauded. Many times he, himself, could not recognize the deception and attributed his failures to other causes. All this was discouraging and led to no possible hope of improvement. At one time in England the collecting and killing of weed seeds to serve as adulterants was a regular commercial business. Particles of quartz were graded and colored in Europe to adulterate clover seed.

The seed testing work done by the Federal Government and by the many state laboratories backed up by suitable and continually improved legislation has done much to discourage the use of crude adulterants or the misbranding of commercial seed. There are some illegitimate practices still too prevalent, like selling the less

desirable strains of imported clovers for the use of the American farmers and the adulterating of Kentucky blue-grass with the cheaper Canada blue-grass. Some seeds get into the channels of trade which are poor due to age, improper storage, etc., but in general the farmer's interests are fairly well protected today and will continue to get better insurance as the equipment of our laboratories and methods of analyzing are perfected.

Erratum

Immediately following the publication of our last seed bulletin Messrs. Thompson and Hoague asked for exhaustive re-examinations in regard to the germination of sample No. 3929 on page 13, reported below guarantee. The duplicate sample left with Thompson and Hoague by the collector was taken over by the Commissioner of Agriculture and a portion retested by our laboratory. Tested side by side with our original sample, this duplicate showed an improvement of some 15 per cent. Probably our original sample had been subject to damage in some way either in transit or in our laboratory. No one recognizes better than the seed analyst the possibilities of error in this work, and for this reason, particularly, we leave with the vender a duplicate sealed sample and we send out advance sheets covering the reports as they will later be printed in the bulletin. Obvious errors should be called to our attention on receipt of the advance reports to eliminate the difficulty or impossibility of making changes in the bulletin. Sample before mentioned should have been marked "satisfactory." Changing the bulletin at the time the error was discovered would have been practically impossible.
