2018). Also, chamber-group Pena-Akromova duo was one of the four finalists at annual Lynn Chamber Competition in 2018.

Robiyakhon is an Uzbek pianist, who is currently a junior, majored in piano performance at Lynn University Conservatory of Music in Boca Raton, Florida, who continues her musical journey with a brilliant musician- Doctor Roberta Rust. Robiyakhon Akromova started playing piano at the age of 9 in her hometown-Tashkent. In 2015 she has been admitted to the academic Lyceum, named after R.M. Glier, where she studied for three years with an honored teacher - Milova Violetta Fedorovna.

Robiyakhon Akromova had an opportunity to participate in masterclasses with Rebecca Penneys, Nelson Delle-Vigne Fabbri (Belgium) and in the piano duo masterclass with Judith Burganger & Leonid Treer. Besides Solo performances, Robiya is experienced in chamber music concerts and contests, as well as giving piano lessons for children and grown-ups. She is self-motivated, inspiring pianist with a strong sense of artistry.
