EDUCATION AND ADVOCACY FOR GLOBAL SURGERY: THE ROLE AND EVOLUTION OF STUDENT ORGANIZATION INCISION GHENT & BELGIUM.

Background/Aim

Worldwide, five billion people lack access to safe and affordable surgical care. To decrease this number and to reach the goal of the Lancet Commission on Global Surgery, an added 1.27 million surgeons, anesthesiologists, and obstetricians (SAO) are needed by 2030. These SAO's are necessary to meet the target of 20 per 100,000 population (1,2). A well-informed future generation exposed early on to the current gaps of global surgery is necessary to ensure a durable future (2-5).

InciSioN, the International Student Surgical Network, is a non-profit organization by and for students, residents and fellows around the globe. **InciSioN Belgium** has made vast progress with **Ghent** as one of its most active local groups. InciSioN Ghent has collaborated with other student networks in medicine **to fill the educational gap**, to stimulate **advocacy** efforts and to increase **interactions** with the international **network** (3).
