HOW TO TRACK A BILL

1. Navigate to the bills page

Search legislation by: bills, resolutions, legislator and subject



2. Select the bill you want to view

Blue highlighted bills are still active or enrolled while grey bills are no longer moving through the process



Bills for 2020 Session

As bills are introduced during the legislative session, the bill number and short description are included in the list below. Active bills are displayed in blue. All bills must achieve certain milestones within specific deadlines throughout the legislative process in order to remain active. Those bills that do not are displayed in gray once the milestone has passed, and a label of "Inactive" is applied for use by screen reader adaptive technologies.

BILL ACTIONS

The bill actions page contains all information about the life of a bill

- At the top of the page there are three options – All Actions, House Actions or Senate Actions
- The most recent bill action is at the top of the page
- A bill must be authored by a legislator from either the House or Senate
- If the bill passes out of that chamber on third reading, it will go to the other chamber (House to Senate or Senate to House)
- Action starts at bottom and most recent action is at the top (to flip it, click the reverse button)
