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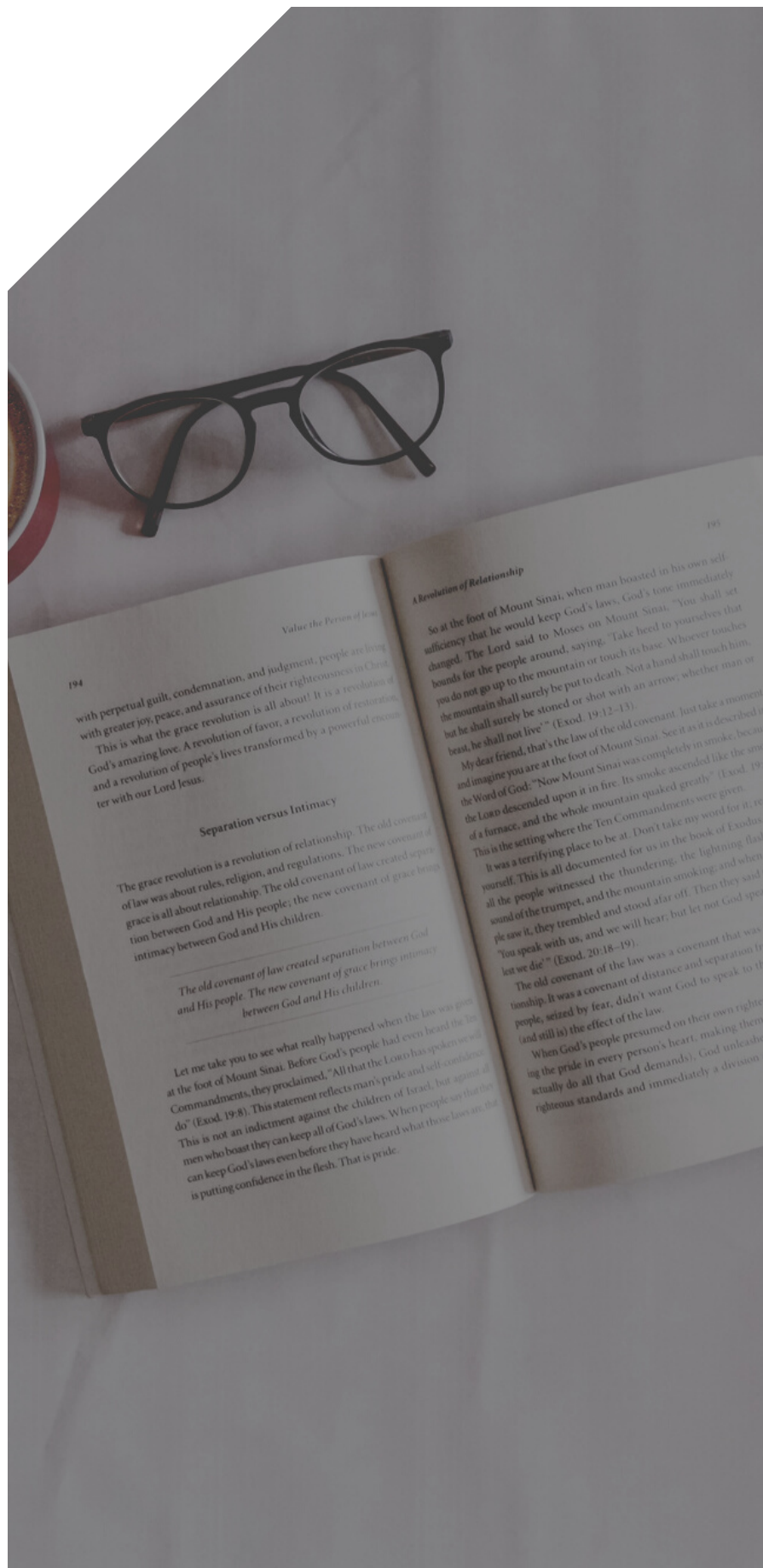

# A brief history of romance novels

► Shakespearean comedies


► 18th and 19th century novels such as Jane Austen's *Pride and Prejudice*

► Modern "rom coms" such as *Bridget Jones's Diary*
