Equal Rights Amendment. HJ 264

Aug. 10, 1970 House passed 352-15 - after the unusual procedure of discharge petition to free from Judiciary Committee + Chairman (opponent) Emanuel Celler (D.N.Y.). Committee had refused to even hold hearings on the amendment, although similar measures have been introduced every year since 1923.

The ERA died in the Senate.
