Construction of the first British 'earthship' in Kinghorn designed by **Mike Raynolds** who run the workshop.

An Earthship is a passive solar building with thermal mass. It is made from natural and recycled materials – predominantly tyres filled with rammed earth and aluminium cans. It is powered by renewable energy, such as wind, water and solar power. It catches its own water supply from rainwater, and treats and contains its own sewage in planter beds.
