


The SuDS wheel of fortune

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Costs / affordability

SuDS Manual: 'deliver the required standard of service and maximise benefits at an affordable cost both to the developer and those funding long-term maintenance'

England: Non-Statutory Standards: 'SuDS are only required if their cost is no more than a conventional drainage system complying with current regulations (providing there is no increase in flood risk'

China: Sponge City Guidelines: 'LID systems should be designed for investment efficiency and economic viability'

Construction and structural integrity

SuDS Manual: 'so that the system can be easily and safely constructed'

England: Non-Statutory Standards: 'Ensure structural integrity of system, adjacent structures and connected systems'
