Dear Mr. Auras,

This is to certify that you were a member of the former D.A.B. in San Francisco, California, for a period of 15 months, (February 1940 to April 1941).

You never were an officer of the organization.

A few weeks before the dissolution of the S.F. branch of the D.A.B., either the last week of October or during the month of November 1941, when you were not a member any more, the Board of Directors persuaded you to temporarily act as the recording Secretary, as you happened to be present at that particular meeting as a guest of a member.

You were never instructed to write any letters for the organization to Germany, as the organization had no connections whatsoever with Germany.
