

 - Journal of Health Ethics

 - Seven titles






The Big Question



- Are the Journals Open?
 - Yes and no
 - Does open mean accessible?
- Other Questions
 - Who is responsible for accessibility?
 - What training is needed?


Building a Plan

- Step 1: Determine
 Who Does What
 - Libraries will identify issues and provide training
 - Editors will make the needed changes on their end




Identifying Challenges

- Step 2: Identifying Common Errors
 - Surveyed five articles from issues of each journal that published in 2020
 - Frequent errors
 - Reading order
 - Section headings
 - Alt-text



Next Steps



- Step 3: Training
 - Targeted for Summer2021
 - Piloting with Gulf and Caribbean Research
 - Initially focus on new articles
 - Evaluate training and then roll out to other journals
