Emily Ellsworth has been Artistic Director of the GECC since 1996. She has prepared the Chorus for performances with the Chicago Symphony Orchestra and Chorus of Mahler's symphonies No. 8 and No. 3 with Christoph Eschenbach, Stravinsky's Symphony of Psalms with Sir Georg Solti, and Mahler's Symphony No. 3 with Claudio bado and the Berlin Philharmonic. She has conducted the young ingers in performances with Julia Roberts, Garth Brooks, Dennis DeYoung, Chicago area orchestras, featured broadcasts on WFMT, four CD recordings, and appearances at national conventions for Chorus America (2004 & 2005) and the American Choral Director's Association (1999 & 2003) as well as concert tours of Italy, Australia/New Zealand, Brazil, Canada and, in 2005, Hong Kong for the World Children's Chorus Festival and mainland China.

Ms. Ellsworth was twice honored to serve on the Music Panel for the National Endowment for the Arts. She received the YWCA's Outstanding Leader for Arts and Culture Award for DuPage County (1999), and is in demand internationally as a guest clinician. She has recently led workshops/choirs throughout the Chicago area, New York, Kansas, Los Angeles, Boston and Oklahoma. She is also the editor of the newly created Opera Workshop series for Boosey and Hawkes Publishing.

Ms. Ellsworth has over 20 years of teaching experience, having rved on the music faculties of the College of DuPage, St. Andrews college in North Carolina, and the University of Southern California. She has also served on the music faculty of Doreen Rao's Choral Music Experience Institute for Choral Teacher Education since 1988. Ms. Ellsworth holds a Bachelor's degree with Special Departmental Honors from Macalester College under Dr. Dale Warland and a Master of Music degree in Vocal Arts with Honors from the University of Southern California. She also holds the Artist/Teacher diploma from the Choral Music Experience Institute.

Ms. Ellsworth has been guest conductor of all-state choirs as well as regional ACDA honor choirs. She is in demand as a conductor and clinician.

Of Dominican descent and born in New York City, Francisco J. Núñez is a composer, conductor, a leading figure in music education, and a visionary, whose strongly held ideas have resulted in the critical and popular success of the Young People's Chorus of New Ork City (YPC). Mr. Nunez formed the YPC in 1988 with two goals in mind: commitments to musical excellence and to providing an atmosphere where young people of diverse ethnic, economic, and religious backgrounds could further their personal and artistic growth through the study and performance of music, and today he is often contacted by cities around the country for help in replicating the YPC success. For his exemplary work with children, Mr. Núñez has been presented with numerous awards, such as the Child Champion award from Child magazine, a Liberty Award from the New York Post, and a Luminary Award from Casita Maria. He was recently named as one of the 100 Most Influential Hispanics of 2005 by Hispanic Business magazine and selected for GMC's advertising campaign as an unsung Hispanic hero doing great work in his community.

Mr. Núñez is also a composer whose award-winning works and arrangements for choirs, orchestras, and solo instruments are inspired by a wide range of Latin cultures and musical idioms. A CD of his music, entitled Cantan, recorded by the Ithaca College Women's Chorus under the direction of Janet Galvan was released in 2004. As a conductor, Mr. Nunez also leads the University Glee Club of New York City, the New York University Singers and NYU Women's Chorus, is active as a guest conductor and master teacher for choral workshops, demonstrations, and festivals nationwide. He will conduct the 2nd ACDA National Multicultural Honor Choir in March of 2007.

Mr. Núñez and the YPC are impacting the world of choral music through their groundbreaking Transient Glory series of concerts, CDs and publications, by commissioning today's most distinguished composers to write music for children's choirs.

Born in Chicago, Jeffery Meyer began his musical studies as a pianist, and shortly thereafter continued on to study composition and conducting. He is presently the Director of Orchestras at the Ithaca College School of Music, as well as the founder and Artistic Director of the St. Petersburg Chamber Philharmonic in St. Petersburg, Russia. Jeff has worked with orchestras in the United States and abroad, including ensembles such as the Milwaukee Symphony Orchestra. In recent concert seasons, he has been seen conducting, performing as piano soloist and chamber musician, as well as conducting from the keyboard in the United States, Canada, Russia, and Germany.

An active participant in the music of our time, he has collaborated with many composers, and commissioned and premiered many new works. He has been featured numerous times as both a conductor and pianist as part of the "Sound Ways" International New Music Festival in St. Petersburg, Russia. As a pianist, Jeff has been in residence at the Banff Centre for the Arts, and in residence at the Aspen Festival as part of the Furious Band, a New York-based grou dedicated to contemporary music. He performs frequently with percussionist Paul Vaillancourt as part of the piano and percussion duo *Strike*. He has been broadcast on CBC Newfoundland, has recorded and performed with the Philadelphia Virtuosi (Naxos), and has been heard as a soloist at the Aspen Festival. During the 2001-2002 academic year he lived and studied in Berlin and Leipzig as the recipient of a DAAD grant in music. He was selected as a semifinalist in the 2004 Pedrotti International Competition for Conductors, a finalist in the 2003 Vakhtang Jordania International Conducting Competition, and a semi-finalist in the 2003 Beethoven Sonata International Piano Competition, Memphis, Tennessee.

, eff is an active adjudicator, guest clinician, and masterclass teacher and has served on the faculties of the Dorian Keyboard Festival, Blue Lake Fine Arts Camp, Marrowstone Music Festival, and the Lutheran Summer Music Academy and Festival. He holds degrees in piano as well as composition and completed his Doctorate of Musical Arts at the State University of New York at Stony Brook, where he studied with Gilbert Kalish.

Curvin G. Farnham is Director of Bands at the University of Maine in Orono, Maine where he conducts the University Symphonic Band, teaches courses in instrumental music education and teaches conducting at the graduate level. In addition to being Associate Conductor of the University Chamber Orchestra, he serves as Coordinator for the School of Performing Arts. Mr. Farnham received his B.M. in Music Education from the Northern Conservatory of Music and did his graduate work at the Vandercook College of Music in Chicago. He has studied conducting with Cichard Castiglione formerly of the Boston Conservatory and nthony Maiello, Director of Instrumental Studies at George Mason University.

He is past president of the Maine Music Educators Association. In 1985 he was elected to the American School Band Directors Association and in 1990 he become a member of Pi Kappa Lambda. Mr. Farnham holds membership in the Music Educators National Conference, the College Band Directors National Association, the New England College Band Directors Association, and the National Band Association. He holds honorary membership in both Kappa Kappa Psi and Tau Beta Sigma. In the spring of 2001 he was recognized as Music Educator of the Year by the Maine Music Educators Association

Mr. Farnham appears throughout the United States and Canada as a clinician, adjudicator and conductor and has guest conducted at several national and international festivals including the Music ^Fducators National Conference Eastern Division Conference and the id-West International Band and Orchestra Clinic in Chicago.


