- Smart Start FYE: Impetus to revamp instruction session

Next Steps

- Plan to create a similar lesson for ENG 101
 - Library activities include options for shorter or longer sessions.
 - Consider information literacy objectives as well as the course objectives.
- Plan to incorporate more active learning activities into classes i.e. Twitter hashtags activity for introducing keywords and subject headings, group activity in which students evaluate resources according to given criteria.
- Reexamine the assessment and the tools used for in-person instruction and virtual instruction.
