The SEAMEN'S CLUB was built in 1866-67 by Charles Clapp just after the great Portland fire in 1866. During the following years it housed many small businesses, including two tailor shops. Then, during the 1940's the building was actually used as a Seamen's Club, a gathering place for out of port seamen.

The architecture is typically gothic; the beautiful, broad windows are known as gothic lights. The windows are enclosed in four intertwining, pointed arches topped with carved wooden medallions.
