The 2nd Innovation and Analytics Conference & Exhibition (IACE 2015) was held at the TH Hotel in Alor Setar, Kedah during 29 September – 1 October 2015 by the School of Quantitative (SQS), Universiti Utara Malaysia (UUM). The 110 participants, of whom 51 were postgraduate students and 12 were from the industry, had many valuable discussions and exchanges which contributed to the success of the conference.

The 95 papers and two posters that were presented in two days covered various areas encompassing Mathematics, Statistics, and Decision Technology. These three main areas are very close to the core of the research and education conducted in SQS, and the theme of IACE 2015, which is "Nurturing Analytical Minds for Innovative Solutions." In between plenary sessions, three invited speakers gave lectures that were closely related to their current research. Mr. Mohd Hazim from PLC International Sdn. Bhd., who is currently doing his PhD in UUM, gave a new perspective on curbing obesity in his lecture titled "Hydrotherapy: An Innovative Treatment for Obese Malaysians", Dr. Nor Idayu Mahat gave a lecture titled "Comparisons of Parametric and Non-Parametric Classification Rules for E-Nose and E-Tongue" in which she discussed the performance of parametric and non-parametric classification ruled in sensor technology, and Dr. Zakiyah Zain gave a lecture titled "Simplifying Multivariate Survival Analysis Using Global Score Test Methodology."

IACE 2015 would not have been a success if not for the strong support from several groups of people. We would like to extend our gratitude towards the keynote and invited speakers, presenters, participants, reviewers, SQS administration and academic staff, and also SQS postgraduate students for their continuous support to IACE 2015.
