Hidalgo County was created from a portion of Cameron County on January 24, 1854, and was organized on August 2 of the same year. Edinburgh, located on the north bank of the Rio Grande opposite Reynosa, was selected as the county seat. Its name was changed to Hidalgo at some time between August 15, 1859 and August 19, 1861.

On October 10, 1908 the county seat was moved from Hidalgo to Chapin. During February 1911 the name of the county seat was changed from Chapin to Edinburg. (Note also change in spelling).

From 1850 through Reconstruction days there were many changes in county officials by failure to qualify, resignations, removals from office and appointments made by state and federal officials. It appears that the dates opposite the names of some of these offi-

cials, as recorded in the Election Registers, from which this information was obtained, are incorrect. Thesee Election Registers for 1852 through 1898 are in the Archives Department of the Texas State Library. Those from 1900 through 1962 are in the office of the Secretary of State in the Capitol.

No doubt there are many errors but names and dates were copied as they are recorded.

Hidalgo County had a "Chief Justice" in the first 16 years of its history — from 1852 to 1868, when this office seems to have been assumed by the County Judge who was appointed by the Governor for the first time in 1868.

Hidalgo Co. has had a Co. Supt. of Schools since 1892.

The county did not have a county attorney until 1878. Evidently there was not enough crime in the early days to justify it.

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CONGRESSMEN

(EDITOR'S NOTE—When Mr. Stambaugh prepared the first of this history, the representatives and Congressmen were omitted. Because the County has been in so many Districts, Congressional, Senatorial and Representative thru these 110 years, it has been difficult to secure an accurate list. This is the information as recorded in the Archives Dept. of the Texas State Library, with the names for some of the latter years supplied by local records.)

From 1852 to 1872, inclusive, only the number of the district, the name of the congressman, and the date of election or appointment were recorded in the Election Register. Therefore, I could not determine in which district the Valley and Hidalgo County were included. So, I am listing all congressmen by districts during that period.
