PRESS RELEASE FOR MESSENGER PRESS FROM THE PREMIER AND
MEMBER FOR NORWOOD, DON DUNSTAN.

SUBJECT: TRAFFIC LIGHTS.

30/8/71.

Four new sets of traffic lights are to be installed in the Norwood area by June next year, the Premier and Member for Norwood, Don Dunstan, announced today.

One will be at the corner of Kensington and Glynburn Roads, scheduled for installation next February.

Another will be at the corner of Fullarton Road and The Parade, scheduled for installation by June next year.

The third will be at the corner of Dequetteville Terrace and Rundle Road, due to be operative next May, and the fourth will be at the corner of Dequetteville Terrace and Bartels Road, scheduled for installation by May next.

In addition the traffic lights at the Payneham Road, Stephen Terrace and Nelson Street intersection are to be modified by next March to provide motorists with safer conditions.

The Premier said the total cost of these works was estimated at nearly \$80,000 of which the Government would bear about three-quarters.

The Premier said the new installations and modification would improve safety factors at these intersections for motorists and pedestrians alike and would better improve traffic flow at these places.
