Copy Machine

It is the concensus opinion of this committee that a copy machine should be available to students for the greatest possible number of hours.

At present, the university maintains 1 copy machine in the College of Education Library and 3 copy machines in the Helm-Cravens Library which are available to general student use. The copy machine in the CEB Library is located on the 3rd floor, and is available only for restricted hours (7:45 a.m. - 8 p.m. Monday through Thursday, 7:45 - 4:30 p.m. Friday.)

It is therefore obvious that the students are in need of a more readily accessible service than is presently in effect, especially on the south end of campus. A possible solution is the placement of a machine in the Downing University Center.

Therefore, be it resolved that the Associated Student Government request the investigation of the feasibility of locating a copy machine in the Downing University Center, to be located next to the bookstore (near the stairwell, on the 3rd floor.)
