BUDGET PREPARATION

The departmental budget requests are currently under review as the process continues for the preparation of the 1980-81 Operating Budget. The procedures will continue for the next several weeks.

The schedule followed in finalizing the budget will depend upon the developments with the 1980-82 Biennial Budget for the state. Since 1980-81 is the first year of the biennial budget (1980-82), the completion of the 1980-81 Operating Budget will have to be delayed until we know the funds we will have available for salaries and our needs.

The budget calendar provides for the 1980-81 budget to be presented to the Board of Regents at the quarterly meeting scheduled for April 26. Since the budget for the biennium has not been presented to the legislature, it may not be possible to have our budget completed by April 26.

REPORT ON MEETING OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS

The Board of Regents met in regular session on January 26, 1980. The Board approved the redesignation of the graduate program in communication disorders to a Master of Science in Communication Disorders.

Approval was given to a plan to reduce from five to three the number of theses directed for a three-hour teaching load assignment.
