WKLT is a week-long learning experience for low-income women and their children (ages 6-14) in Warren and neighboring counties. On WKU's campus, women take classes and participate in workshops and team-building activities designed to strengthen self-esteem, build certain job skills, and explore opportunities for life-long education. Activities incorporate the arts, creativity, self-expression, and help to increase awareness about the



community and civic engagement. The children's portion of WKLT encourages the participants' children to be creative and to express themselves in a positive and healthy manner. The children participate in drama, artistic expression, and creative writing classes where WKU students will teach them.



WKLT is a joint venture of the Bowling Green Housing Authority and the WKU Women's Studies Program.
