WESTERN KENTUCKY UNIVERSITY

Western Kentucky University is located in Bowling Green, a progressive and fast-growing southern Kentucky city of 36,000 residents.

Easily accessible, the city is served by air, rail, and bus lines. U. S. Highway 31W and Interstate 65 intersect with U. S. Highway 68 and 231 at Bowling Green, and the main line of the L & N Railroad passes through the city. Three bus lines serve the community and Eastern Air Lines has scheduled flights north and south each day from the city airport.

Western's undergraduate division provides four-year programs leading to the Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Science, Bachelor of Fine Arts, and the Bachelor of Music Degrees. Thirty-eight (38) academic majors, forty (40) academic minors, and thirteen (13) areas of concentration are available. Three general curricula—arts and science, teacher education and special studies—are provided. Moreover, there are a number of professional and pre-professional curricula.

Two-year programs leading to the Associates of Arts Degree in Agricultural Technology and Management, Industrial Technology, Small Business Management, Data Processing, and Secretarial Administration are offered. In addition, a two-year program leading to the Associate of Science Degree is offered in Engineering Technology (Civil, Electrical and Mechanical). Moreover, the University offers the Associate of Science Degree in Nursing and a one-year Secretarial Science program.

The Graduate School offers the Master of Arts in Education, English, Government, History, Humanities, Psychology, Sociology, and Spanish. Also offered are the Master of Science in Agriculture, Biology, Chemistry, Geography, Mathematics, Physics and Astronomy, and Physical Education, and the Master of Science in Engineering Physics. Additional master's degree programs are Master of Arts in College Teaching (in Humanities and in Spanish), Master of Science in College Teaching (in Biology, in Chemistry, in Geography, and in Mathematics), Master of Business Administration, Master of Music, and Master of Public Service. A Doctor of Education is offered as a cooperative program with the University of Kentucky and George Peabody College for Teachers.

The Colleges of the University

The Graduate School:

The expanding Graduate School offers nine graduate degrees and participates in joint doctoral programs with the University of Kentucky and with George Peabody College for Teachers.

The Bowling Green College of Commerce:

Departments of Accounting, Business Administration, Economics, Government, Sociology and Anthropology, and Office Administration.

The College of Education:

Departments of Elementary Education, Secondary Education, Psychology, Industrial Education, Home Economics, Physical Education, Health and Recreation; other areas include the Laboratory School, School Administration Programs, Reading Services, Educational Research, Counselor Education, and Audio-Visual Aids Services.

The Potter College of Liberal Arts:

Departments of Art, English, Foreign Languages, History, Music, Philosophy and Religion, and Speech and Theatre.

The Ogden College of Science and Technology:

Departments of Agriculture, Biology, Chemistry, Georgraphy and Geology, Mathematics, Physics and Astronomy, and Engineering Technology Programs.

Other Distinctive Programs:

In addition to the departments listed under the Colleges, three departments (Nursing, Library Science, and Military Science) are directed by the Associate Dean for Undergraduate Instruction. Pre-professional and professional curricula are available in several areas.
