Biographical/Historical Note: Arndt Mathis Stickles came to WKU in 1908 to head the History department and remained until his retirement in 1954. Born in Patricksburg, Indiana in 1872, Stickles was the son of Mathis & Elizabeth (Kiefaber) Stickles. Dr. Stickles died January 4, 1953. While at WKU Stickles published several works related to the history of Kentucky and the Civil War.
