CONTRACT

We here by agree to cast in bronze the ten foot portrait statue of Dr. H. H. Cherry now standing in the studio of the late Mr. Lordo Taft for the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00).

The payment for the work to be arranged as follows: One third of the amount, or \$833.33 to be paid at the time of transfer of the Dr. Cherry figure from the Lorado Taft studio to the foundry of Bronze, Inc., at 1250 No. Central Avenue, Chicago, Ill.

The second payment of \$833.33 to be paid at the time the casting in bronze is completed.

The third payment of \$833.34 to be made on completion of the finished statue in bronze or within one year's time from the date of arrival of the plaster model at the foundry.

It is understood Bronze, Inc., will stand the cost of transfer of the plaster model from the Taft studio to its foundry. We will also crate the statue ready for final shipment to Bowling Green, Ky,
