## THE JABBERWOCK

The Jabberwock is an activity peculiar to Delta Sigma Theta. The first Jabberwock was presented in 1925 in Boston, Massachusetts, by members of Iota Chapter. In an effort to find some new method of raising money for her chapter's scholarship fund, Marion Hope Conner of Iota Chapter conceived the idea of a variety show of a kind that would interest groups and individuals in producing skits, dances, and songs in competition for prizes for varying amounts. She called this new kind of show a "Jabberwock," a title taken from Lewis Carroll's tale, Alice's Adventures in Wonderland. The term is quite suitable for the variety of clever nonsense presented in a Delta Jabberwock.

Today the Jabberwock is considered a Delta institution, and many local communities eagerly anticipate the event. An important aspect of this innovation in entertainment is the friendly open rivalry it affords all Greek-letter organizations-the chance to compete with each other in providing glittering light entertainment and at the same time cooperate for a worthy end. Other civic and social organizations are also encouraged to participate in the Jabberwock, thereby providing a showcase for the talents of each group.

Jabberwock funds are earmarked for scholarships to be given by the sponsoring chapter to young women of promise and ability, and for public service projects. Besides this, the Jabberwock offers encouragement and practical help to the development of any talent that groups or individuals may possess from pre-school to adult age-level.

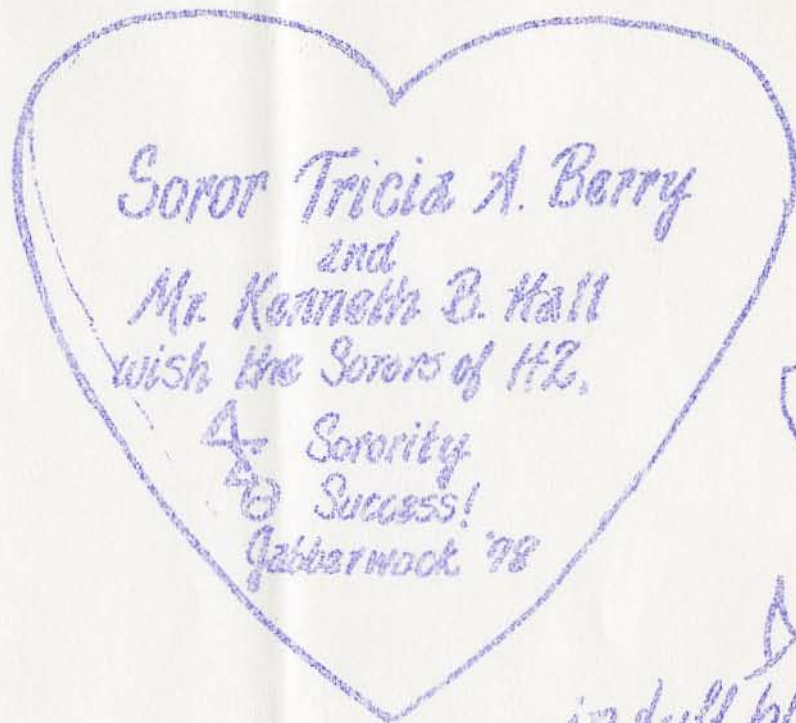

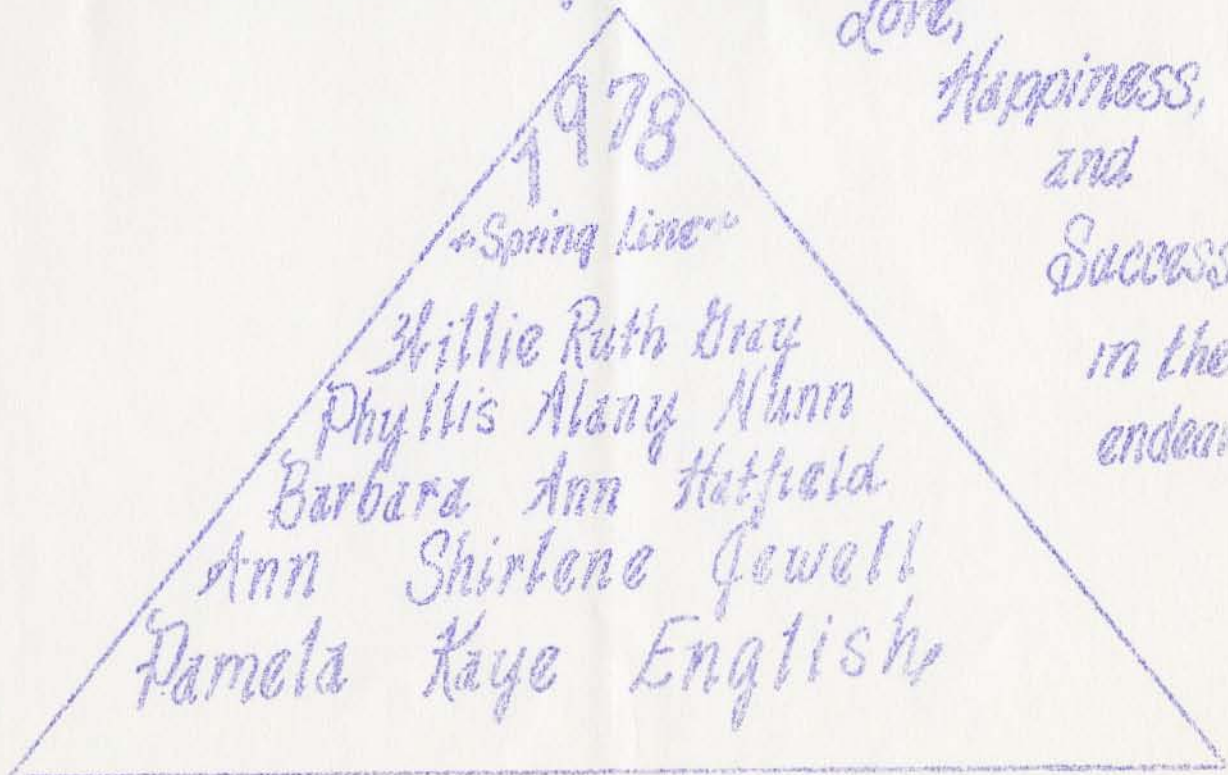

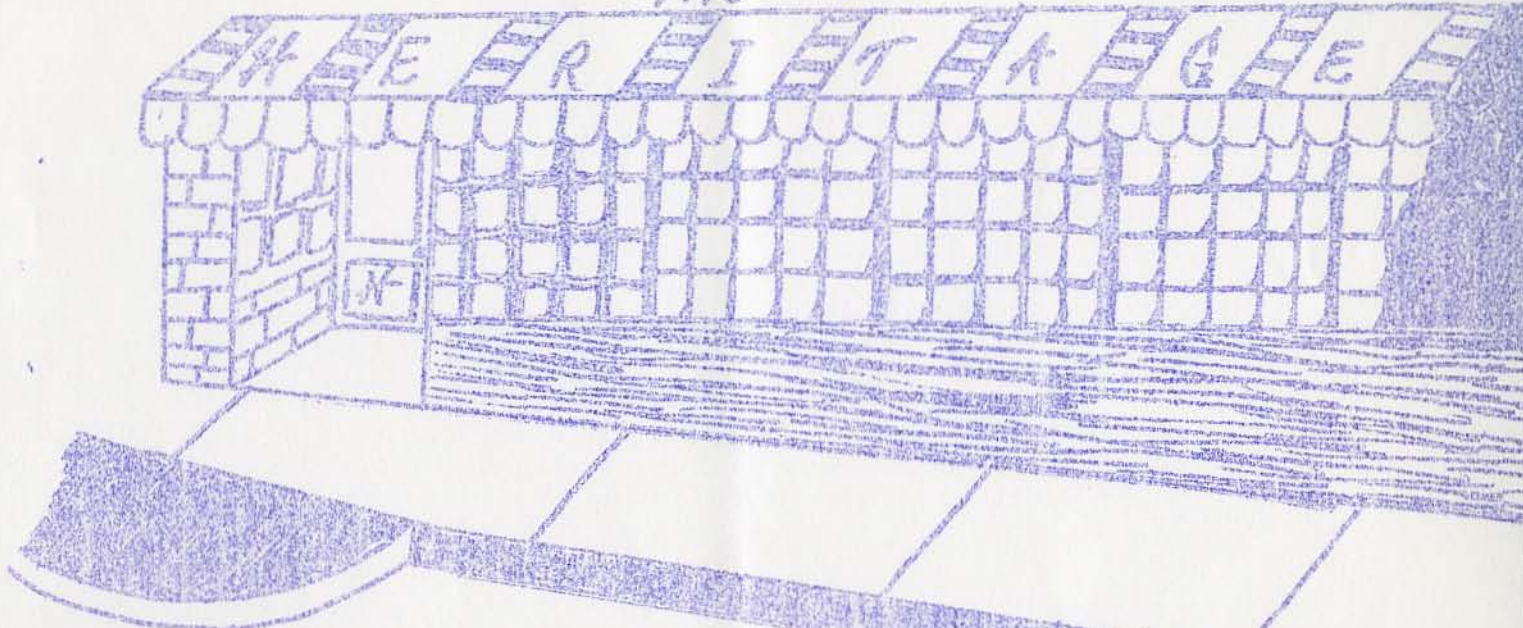
