- Whereas, state and federal budget cuts have vastly effected the area of higher education, and
- Whereas, the resulting lack of monies at Western Kentucky University has caused increased pupil/instructor ratios in classes; freezes on hiring of university personnel; tuition increases; the dissolution of many presently offered services and the prevention of implementation of many other services, thus impeding the desired progressive nature and evolution of this university, and
- Whereas, this impediment is a source of distress and dissatisfaction to its students, and
- Whereas, Associated Student Government exists to represent the students of WKU,
- Therefore, be it resolved that the Student Congress of ASG obligates itself to the voicing of the students' dissatisfaction regarding the financial state of this university, and

Furthermore, that the 81 Student Congress agrees to work toward the following objectives:

- Assertion of its support for WKU President Donald Zacharias in his endeavor to gain fair and adequate monetary allotments for this university;
- Unification of WKU's student body behind the endeavors of the president;
- (3) Restraint of further budget cuts;
- (4) Retaining money generated by WKU tutition increases here at WKU;
