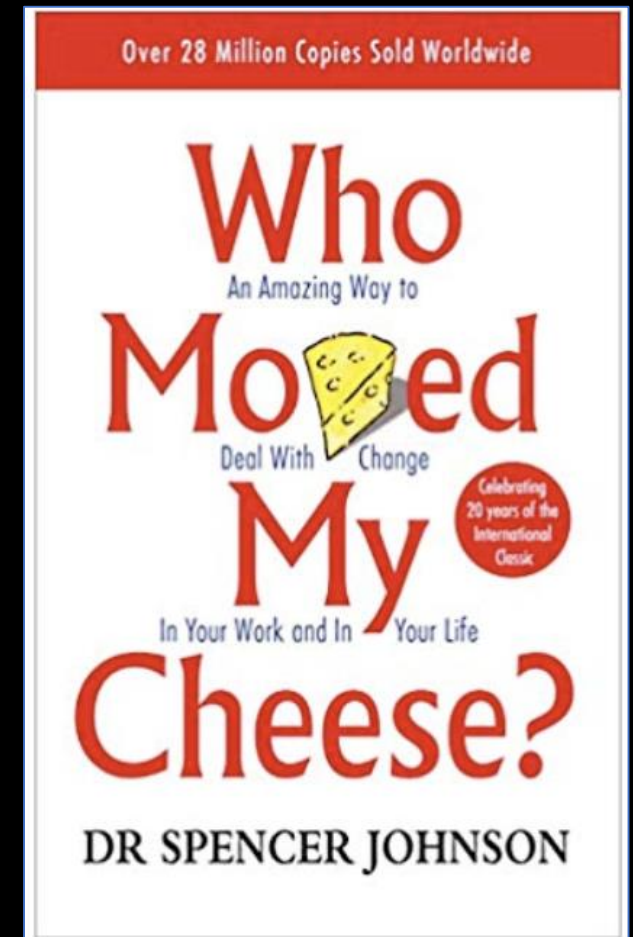

A sign of its times . . . individual anxiety

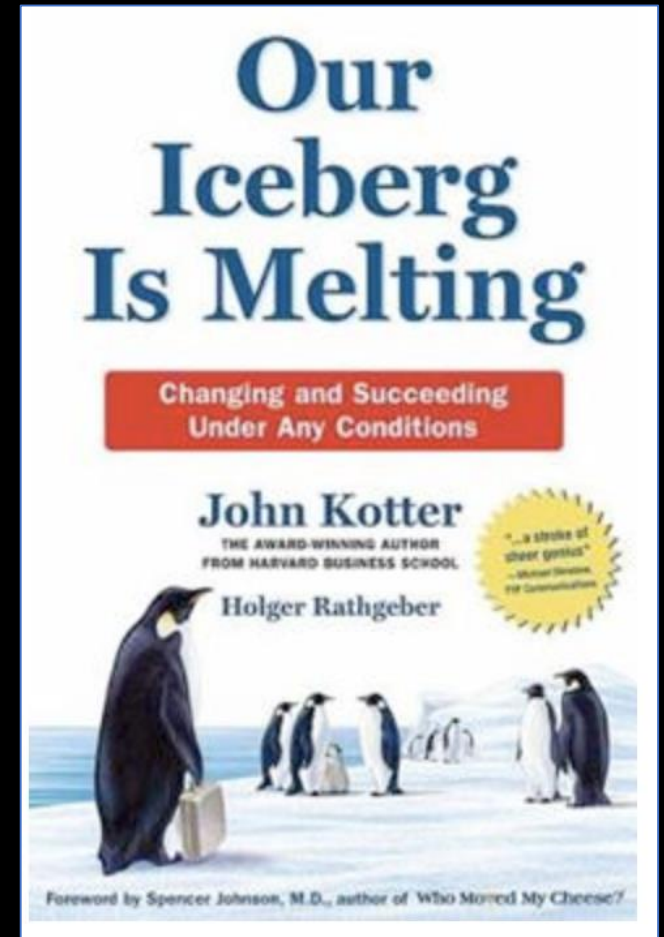
Change is inevitable--nothing lasts forever,
