"<u>SciTopics</u> is designed to be a starting point for researchers to gain an introductory overview of a particular topic, while also identifying sources for a more in-depth analysis and coverage of that topic. Unlike other web services for the scientific community, *SciTopics* does not focus on one specific scientific discipline, but is open to researchers from all scientific areas."

The research articles published in *Arthritis Research and Therapy, Breast Cancer Research* and *Genome Biology* are open-access content. All articles in the other four titles, which are review journals, are closed to non-subscribers. Full-text articles from these journals for 2010 may be obtained for a fee through the *Interlibrary Loan* department.
