#### INTRODUCTION

This will be the last version of the library annual report in this format. As part of discussions that took place during performance reviews in Fall 2001, it was agreed that with our migration to teams and working groups, a preferred version would be to do less formal annual reports, and more frequent summaries that provide up-to-date information on library progress and accomplishments. Monthly updates and semi-annual reports with end-of-year statistical compilations will replace this format. As we have moved to a new millennium, it is agreed that a new means of keeping a record of the library progress will replace this once-a-year compilation.

Therefore, this report will be a brief summary of the highlights for the year 2000-2001, a report on progress for the goals of the year, a list of next year's goals, with attached statistical documents.

#### YEAR IN REVIEW - HIGHLIGHTS

- CLICnetIII The process to select a new automated catalog system began in September 1999 and the CLIC Board reached a decision in June 2000 to migrate from Dynix to III (Innovative Interfaces.) The migration began in March 2001, and it is anticipated that the system migration will be completed prior to school beginning in 2001. Clem participated on the group that set the parameters for the system and contributed a significant amount of overtime during December and January in order to make a deadline imposed by III.
- **Completed the barcode cleanup project** this was a seven year project completed in the Summer of 2000.
- Fire at Hamline Library start of Fall 2000, impacted us as we provided library access for Hamline students until January 2001
- Development of a campus portal Under the direction of the Web Working Group
  which included David Sisk, CIT we developed a plan and implemented a pilot

project. Ron Joslin was project manager, and Sara Suelflow did the programming. Using ColdFusion, we created MyInfo with initial pilot rollout in the Fall of 2000. We started small, did a review of the project in January, and determined that we could sustain the project and introduced MyInfo to the campus in the Spring of 2001. During the Summer of 2001 we were going to implement some additional changes and do a fullscale implementation in the Fall of 2001.

- Wireless networking and Laptop checkout very successfully implemented in November 2000
- Remote proxy server outsourced to Obvia and remote access was available by November 2000. Ron and Sara cooperated on this project.
- Implemented web forms for interlibrary loan and acquisitions
- Weeding of print periodicals Jean and Dani worked on in summer of 2000 and worked with departments and faculty to eliminate titles in the print collection
- New display case installed main lobby for Rare Books Collection donation of David Foster, '67
- Macalester was cited in <u>Chronicle of Higher Education</u> "alumni scored 73% above
  the norm in the area of 'information finding' one of many criteria used to measure
  the knowledge confidence of students who graduated between 1992 and 1994."

- Completed two online surveys laptop checkout and interlibrary loan

   successful online geography course.

Ron, Geri, and David Sisk worked to complete the wireless networking. Laptop checkout was begun in November 2000 and proved to be one of our most popular and successful services.

97.5% of our materials budget was spent according to our records!
We began with an allocation of \$922,846 (including carry forward and replacement funds) and we spent \$900,182.

We differ slightly from the cost center reports and expect that their final report in August will show us spending approx. \$892,439.

The Business office denied two invoices (over \$17,000) in with the 2000/01 Fiscal year. Obviously, if they had not, we would have come much closer to spending our budget.

We should be pleased with: the small discrepancy with the business office (c. \$7,700), and the high percentage of our materials budget spent -- 96.6%-97.5%. We also managed to leave funds unspent to assist with balancing the overall library budget as Terri requested.

This has been a very good year!
