
Theatre and Dance Department Presents "Sing Protest, Sing Peace"

Sing Protest, Sing Peace kicks off the Theatre and Dance Department's season theme of "Youth Cultures," setting the stage for a season of new and devised work. Using physical theatre techniques and the pedagogy of Jacques Lecoq, an ensemble of six Macalester first-years, guided by awardwinning Fringe director Isabel Nelson '04, breathe life into a not-so-distant story of social unrest: the history of textile workers in turn-of-the century America. With New York City as its background, and the Uprising of the 20,000 in 1909-10 and the Triangle Fire of 1911 as its historical inspiration, *Sing Protest, Sing Peace* investigates questions of love, duty, and honor in a time of struggle.
