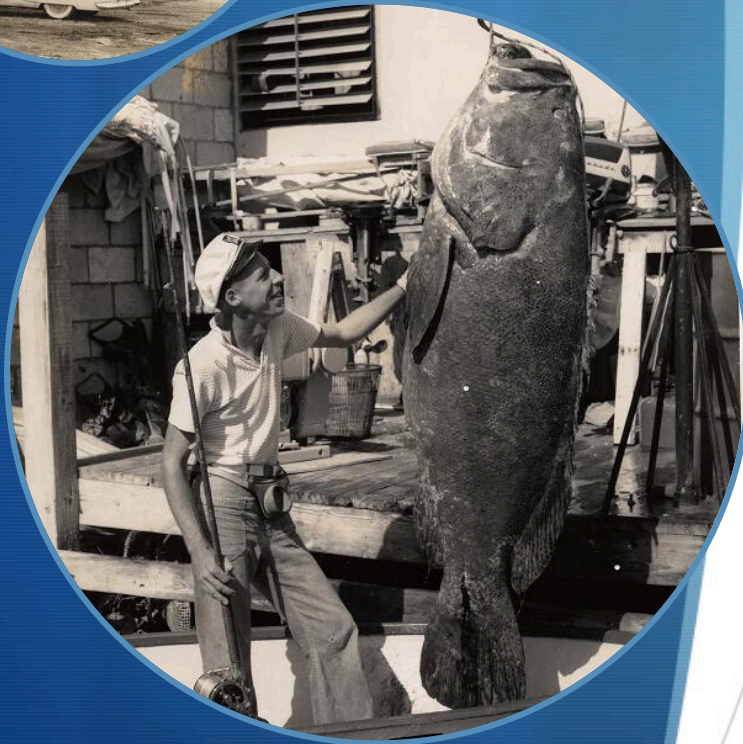

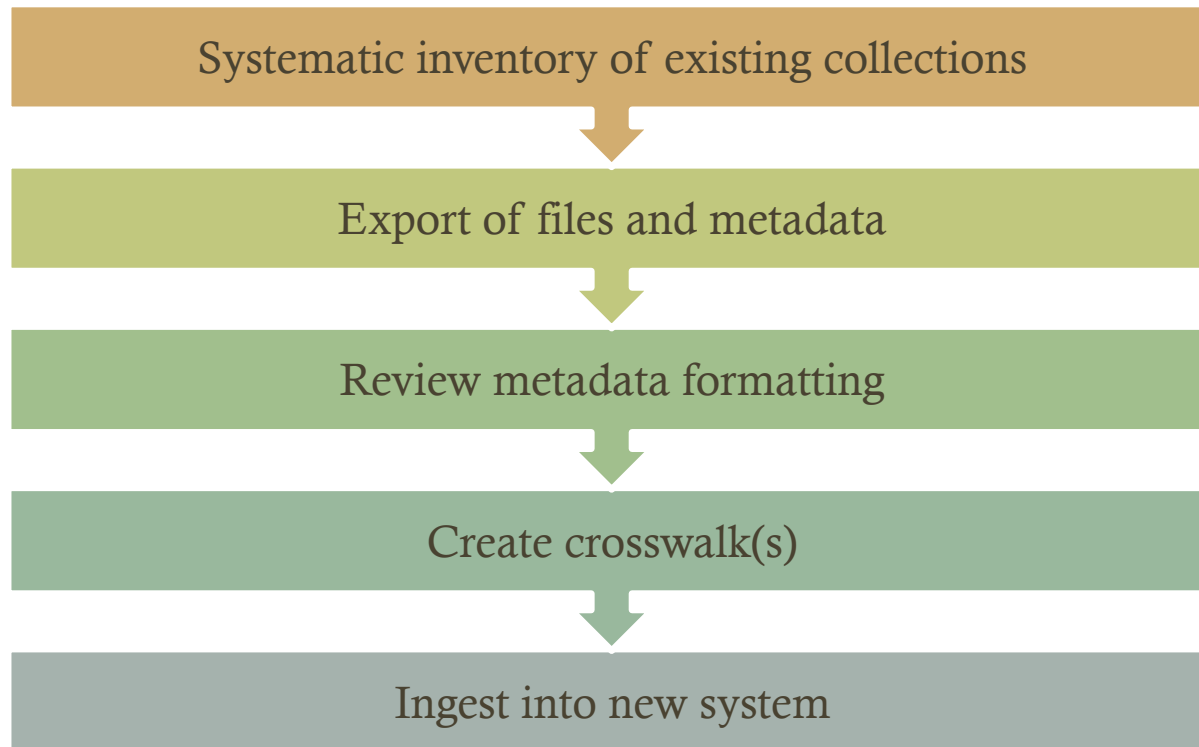

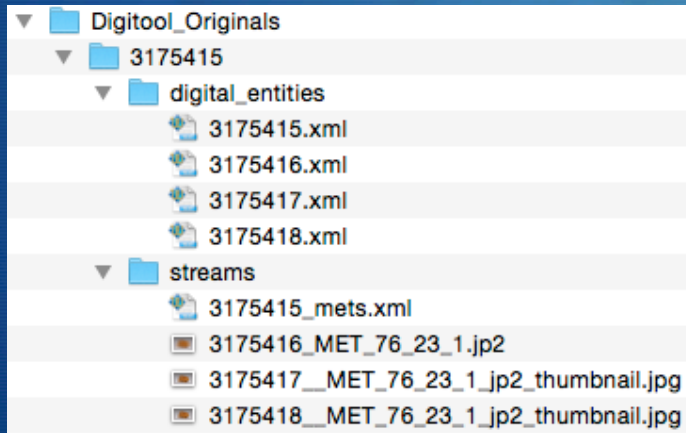
Exporting files and metadata in a format that will be useful is not always an easy task, depending on the system.

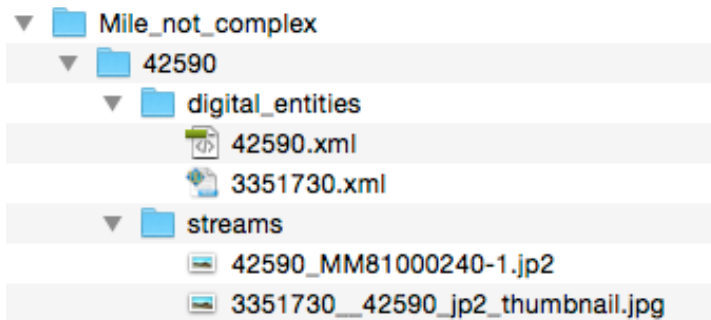

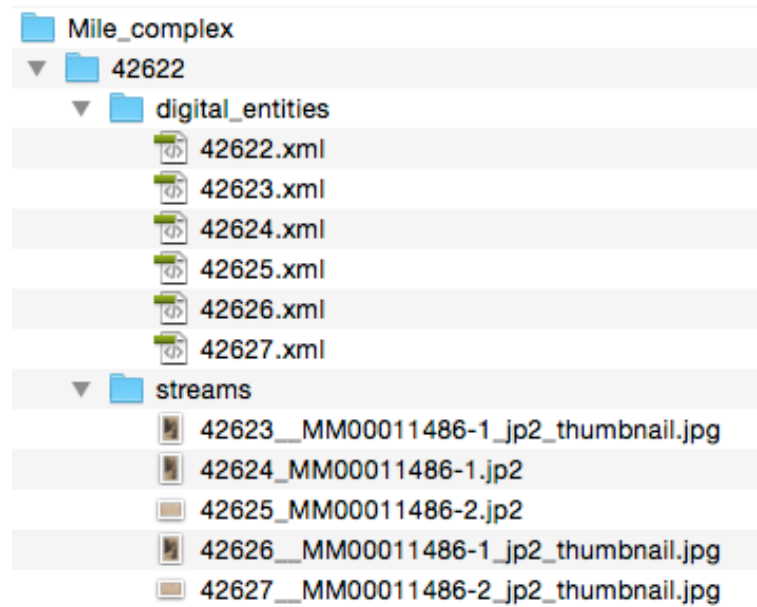

Metadata Review

- ❖ What we found...
 - ❖ Descriptive metadata in MARC and Dublin Core
 - ❖ System generated XML file names (not IDs we use/track)
 - ❖ For each record:
 - ❖ 1 system generated XML for parent level record
 - ❖ System generated XMLs for each file (PDF, JPG, etc.)
 - ❖ Only newer records have METS files
 - ❖ METS files were saved as data streams and were not updated
 - ❖ System generated XML files did include updated metadata
