Laryngology Prize. By Professor Kyle, Twenty-five Dollars, for the best Original Essay on a subject pertaining to Laryngology and Rhinology, to Robert Boyd Pratt, with honorable mention of Warren B. Davis and Samuel Halleck Craig.

Alumni Prize. By the Alumni Association, a medal, for the best general average gained in the Examination for the entire Curriculum, to Horace E. Happel.
