

Lessons Learned - CONS

- ❑ Very time consuming
- ❑ Each template file (.tpl) has to be touched/modified
- ❑ Design changes are no longer in the hands of the journal managers/editors
- ❑ Future upgrades could potentially cause display issues

Lessons Learned - PROS

- Creates a unique look for the journal instance
- High satisfaction from faculty involved
- Showpiece for collaboration with faculty
- Supports a faculty member advocating OA and Library services
- Demonstrates need for value-added web design services and need for additional resources
