To have our University of Maine give or sanction the activities of Homo-Sexualists "GAY PEOPLE" as any other Organization of the College - seems to me to be in very bad taste - and ignorance. These people are not NORMAL People They are FREAKS, just as the abnormally formed Human Beings in Circus Side Shows are FREAKS: the Dwarfs - Siamese Twins - Fat LADY # Thin Man - Giant -Dog Faced Boy etc.... only the horrible DIFFERENCE is that - like DRUG PUSH-ORS - the GAY PEOPLE are always seeking RECRUITS to help them play their GAME - Little Children being prime targets for their attention. GAY PEOPLE do not have GOOD INTENTIONS for Normal People - so except for "it takes one to know one" activities on their part - they should be held in a contamination status similar to Lepers or German Measles - a menace to Polite, Healthy Minded Socie - and treated as such.
