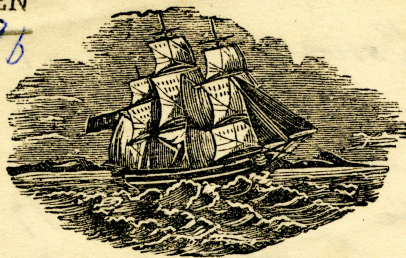

hath affirmed to *three* Bills of Lading, all of this tenor and date,—one of which Bills being accomplished, the other *2* to stand void.

Dated in BALTIMORE, the *24th* day of *October* 185*0*
