This deed made and entered into this 5<sup>th</sup>  
day February A.D. 1887 Between John W White  
and Mary Susan his wife of the first part  
and Samuel W Paulett of the second part  
Witnesseth That for and in consideration  
of the sum of One hundred dollars cash  
in hand paid the receipt whereof is  
hereby acknowledged dothi grant bargain  
sell and convey unto Samuel W Paulett with  
general warranty the following property  
to wit Part of Lot No 31 of J Gardners survey  
Commencing at the intersection of old Grace Street  
with Grove Street the said Old Grace Street  
having been deeded to Samuel W Paulett  
by the Corporation of the town of Farmville  
which is of record in Prince Edward County  
Court Clerks office D.B 37 running along Grove  
street one hundred and seventy one feet  
thence west to S.W. Pauletts line thence  
North to old Grace street one hundred and  
seventy one feet thence East to Grove Street  
to the beginning And for the further con-  
sideration of twenty dollars cash in hand  
paid to the party of the first part by  
S W. Paulett of the second part dothi further  
grant bargain sell and convey another  
lot or parcel of land to wit Commencing  
on Grove Street at the corner of the lot  
conveyed by this deed running along Grove  
street thirty three feet south, thence west  
to S. W. Pauletts line thence North to said  
lot 33 feet as above conveyed thence East

to Grove street to the beginning witness  
our hands and seals this the day and  
year first above written

writing to be her act and deed and  
that she had willing executed the  
same and does not wish to retract it
