Box **650.1** contains a few issues that were not bound (these have been digitized) dates: 11/9/1951, 10/12/1951, 4/11/1952, 4/17/1962, 5/25/1964, 5/10/1965 (X2), 11/2/1972, 11/6/1972(x2), 11/21/1972 (Pirate Preview), and 2/21/1972 Masquer's special edition.

Also here: a publisher's edition of the first volume of the Inkwell, donated by Alva Lines, the first student-editor and a bound 2nd volume of the Inkwell. Extra copies of the 50th anniversary issue (1985), and two issues from 1988 showing editor's mark-ups for changes to the Inkwell's format. Clippings from early inkwells and 2nd copies of a few, early Inkwells.

A partial set of Inkwells are stored in the ARC at the Henderson Library. These are duplicate Inkwells, as available, from 1981-2018.
