ABOUT THE COLLECTION

Administrative History: The Georgia Southern University Archives and Records division was founded in 1972 as a result of the Georgia Records Act of 1972, which legally required government entities in the state of Georgia to manage and maintain records created by the entity. The division collects, preserves, and destroys records in accordance with state law. At Georgia Southern, the division falls under the AVP Finances and Business Services Division. The GSU Archives and Records Management division manages a 10,000 square foot secure warehouse space, where any medium of records (paper, microfilm, digital, and computer tapes) is handled according to best practices.

Scope and Content: This collection consists of event materials published by Georgia Teachers College and Georgia Southern College from 1955 to 1992. Materials include building dedication ceremony programs, booklets, information sheets, and invitations hosted by Georgia Southern College.
