· Georgia Southern opens Sun Belt Conference play in the Pelican State, where the Eagles will take on ULM Friday and Louisiana Saturday.

• The Eagles are coming off three straight wins in the GATA Challenge in Hanner Fieldhouse last weekend. <u>Paige Powers</u> was named tournament MVP, while <u>Ashlyn</u> <u>Lovett</u> and <u>Baylor Bumford</u> were named all-tournament.

• The Eagles' 7-3 record in non-conference play is their best non-league record since 2013, when they went 15-3 in non-conference play, which included a 3-1 mark in the postseason (3-0 in Southern Conference Tourney and 0-1 in NCAA Tourney).

• GS meets ULM and Louisiana for the first time since 2019, when the Eagles lost to both schools at home. GS leads the all-time series against ULM 5-4, has lost the last two and is 2-2 on the road. The Eagles trail the all-time series vs. Louisiana 4-3 and have lost the last three. The Eagles are 2-2 on the road vs. the Ragin' Cajuns.

• <u>Hannah McGlockton</u> ranks seventh in the Sun Belt in kills per set (3.18), and four Eagles are ranked in the top-10 in hitting percentage. <u>Baylor Bumford</u> is second (.359), <u>Paige Powers</u> is sixth (.320), <u>Christina Walton</u> ranks seventh (.318) and <u>Robin Rosser</u> ranks eighth (.313).

• The Eagles rank third in the Sun Belt in aces (1.79/set), third in blocks (2.24/set) and second in hitting percentage (.259). The Eagles' .394 hitting percentage against USC Upstate Saturday was the highest since Oct. 16, 2018, when they hit .441 at South Carolina State.

• <u>Madison Brown</u> is the seventh Eagle to surpass 2,500 assists for her career, and the senior ranks sixth on the Georgia Southern all-time list with 2,590. She ranks fifth in the Sun Belt in assists (9.74/set) and second in aces (0.48/set).

• Baylor Bumford (1.06) and Christina Walton (1.04) rank fourth and fifth in the Sun Belt in blocks.

• Following the weekend, the Eagles return home to face Coastal Carolina next Friday and Appalachian State next Sunday. There's a Block Party prior to Friday's match and it's Family and Alumni Weekend with the Alumni Game set for Sunday.
