to equalize but the Bucs tallied a late goal to pull away for a 3-1 win at the GC Bobcat Shootout on Friday afternoon at Bobcat Field in Milledgeville, Ga.

The Bucs (3-0) remained unbeaten on the season and have scored three goals in all of their wins, but the Pirates (1-2) are the first team so far this season to find the back of the net against Barry. Both teams will conclude action at the GC Bobcat Shootout on Sunday with the Pirates facing Florida Southern at Noon and Barry taking on host Georgia College at 3:00 p.m.

A tight defensive first half got just a lone breakthrough - Lavinia Nkomo's drive down the right flank and subsequent cross attempt curled into the right side of the net for a goal, her third of the season, to stake the Bucs to a 1-0 lead. Armstrong State outshot the Bucs, 9-4, in the first half.

In the second half, Barry extended its lead to 2-0 on another goal by Nkomo, this time getting onto a cross from Amanda Taylor in the 53rd minute in the box and finding the back of the net for the two goal lead.

Armstrong State battled back to cut the gap to one off of a set piece. A free kick from sophomore McKenzie Anderson dropped in the box and junior Erin Berube's shot was blocked, but found the feet of junior **Kennedi Herrmann** in front of the net for her first goal of the season in the 64th minute.

The Pirates had two great chances to equalize - in the 75th minute, Parker Schroedel's try off of a corner kick from six feet in front of the net was high, and in the 79th minute, Taylor Valley's header skipped just wide of the goal. Just three minutes after Valley's header, the Bucs put the match away with Amanda Traynor's second goal of the season, in the 83rd minute, off of an assist by Christy Grimshaw.

Barry finished the match with an 18-15 edge in shots, while each team had four corner kicks apiece. Barry goalkeeper Paula Forero made five saves in net, while Armstrong State goalkeeper Morgan

Luckie made six saves. Barry was whistled for 11 fouls on the day with four whistled on the Pirates.


